On June 23, 2022, Mung Chiang, Dean, College of Engineering sent a memo requesting a posthumous Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering from Purdue University, West Lafayette to Timothy W. St John.

The policy states the awarding of a posthumous degree by Purdue University requires that the deceased student completed:


1. At least 85% of the credit hour requirements


