Overarching Foundational Policies

All Uses must adhere to:

- Academic Integrity
- IP, Copyright & Trademark
- Data Governance, Privacy, and Security
- Research Integrity & Ethics

Acceptable Uses at Course Level

- Contextual and determined by Instructor
- Sometimes Al use is not allowed
 - E.g. if student's individual execution of the work is essential to learning process or assessment
- Sometimes Al use is by design
 - E.g. if learning to use Al as a tool is part of the course learning objectives
