Prospective New Undergraduate Students

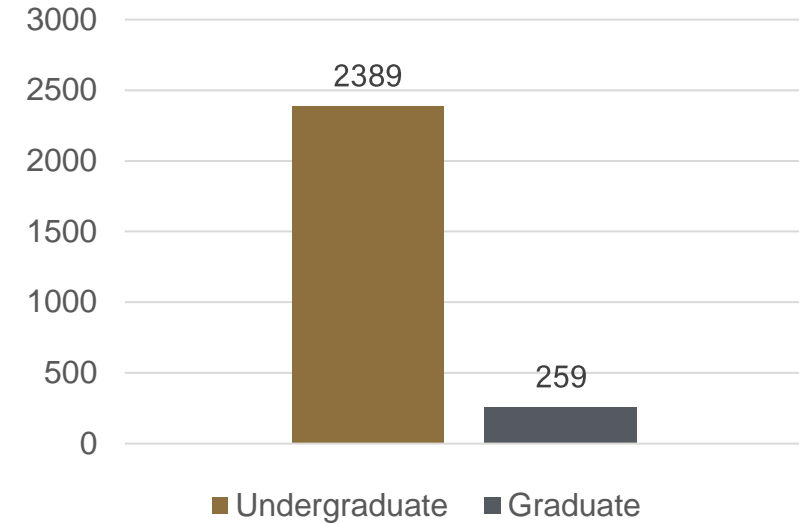
- Offering high-demand majors in Computer Science, Engineering, and Polytech
- Common App enables students to consider Indianapolis as well as West Lafayette
- Direct admission for Engineering majors along with guaranteed internships. Majors offered include:
 - Mechanical Engineering Motorsports Engineering Biomedical Engineering
 - Computer Engineering Electrical Engineering
- Goal of 800 new beginners
- Early Action admission decisions out by January 15
- Campus visits and tours are taking place daily. Visitor and tour capacity increases on January 18
- Planning for Boiler Gold Rush + all other Purdue new beginner activities fully on track

Continuing Students

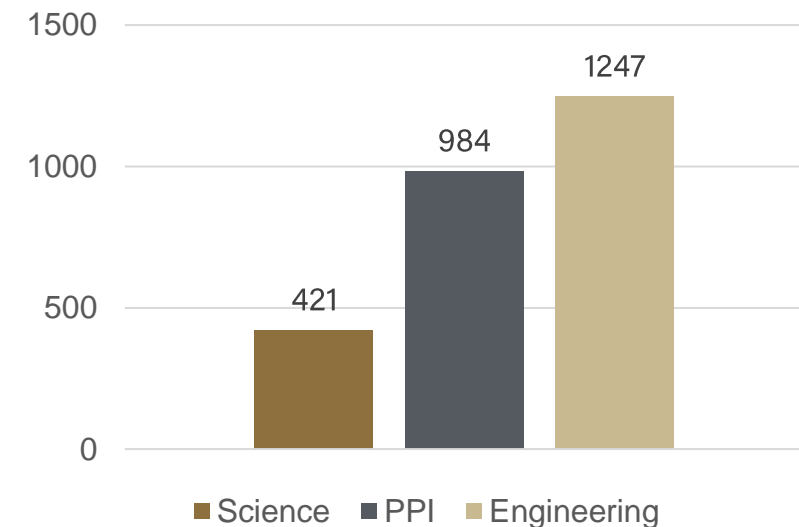
- Approximately 2,650 continuing students
- Advisors currently at work on individual advising plan of study for each student
- Fall 2024 course offering schedule being built
- New 1-credit course ENGR/TECH 29500 The Data Mine for continuing students coming for Spring 2024
- Three student town hall events planned for Fall 2023, with more being planned for Spring 2024

Opportunities for New and Continuing Graduate Students

- Alignment of current IUPUI faculty nearing completion, and:
 - PhD students will ordinarily follow advisor, to best preserve Advisor/Advisee relationship
 - International student transfer process has been codified and shared broadly
 - All 260 current graduate students welcomed into Purdue West Lafayette departments
 - All scholarships, fellowships and full terms of current appointment letters are maintained
 - Our graduate student government is helping build West Lafayette ↔ Indianapolis relationships
 - Teaching Assistantship opportunities for courses in Indianapolis will ordinarily go to graduate students based in Indianapolis
- New programs leveraging Indianapolis location, in line with Purdue strategic priorities:
 - Sports Engineering - Ray Ewry Center for Sports Engineering
 - Pharmaceutical Manufacturing Engineering - Chemical Engineering and College of Pharmacy

- Contracting begins in January 2024

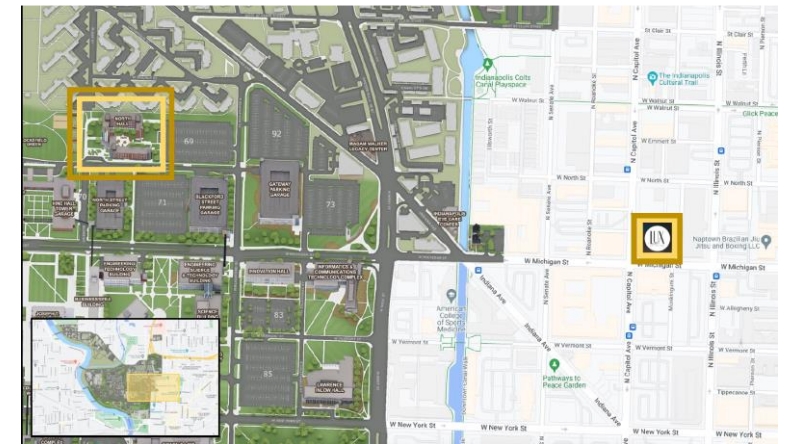


■ Staffing

- Resident Assistant hiring process underway

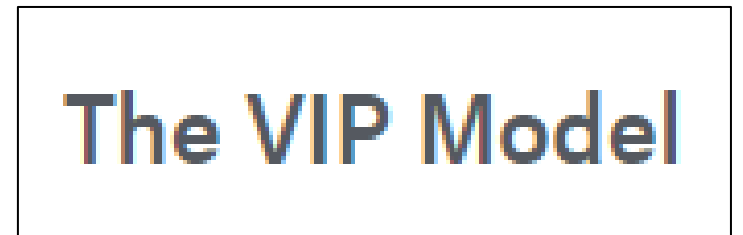
■ Student Activities & Organizations

Teaching and Learning

- Indianapolis course delivery modes
 - Excellent instruction through in-person, hybrid, and online delivery
- Experiential education offerings provide academic credit to new beginners & continuing students
 - **The Data Mine**: 1-cr seminar + 3-cr project options
 - **EPICS**: service-learning design program will engage Indianapolis community partners
 - **VIP (Vertically Integrated Projects)**: design projects supported by research and industry partners
- Honors College presence being developed
- Supporting General Education and STEM Education
 - Faculty and student consortium models

- Daniels School of Business – High Alpha
 - Short course programs currently being developed
