

Transportation and Pedestrian Safety Study

1,533 responses to WL campuswide survey

- Key findings:
 - 71% of students feel safe always or most of the time
 - 60% of faculty and staff feel safe always or most of the time
 - Predominant reason (63%) for feeling unsafe is the unsafe operation of alternative transportation devices and motorized vehicles
 - Improvement strategies from respondents included additional regulations, enforcement and education
- Next steps:
 - Fleet Parking – Require users to end rides at designated parking locations
 - New Student Training – Create a campus safety learning module for new students.
 - Additional Purdue University Police Department (PUPD) Staff– Allow for staffing of 1-2 full-time bike patrol units
 - Dedicated Infrastructure – Continue the development of the infrastructure plan, including additional signs and signals
