<i>Background IP (BIP) contemplated?</i>	Can be, but not necessary. IP outside defined field is market based.	If background IP is sponsor-owned, IP fee charged for license of project IP. If background IP is Purdue owned, sponsor obtains license and no IP fee is charged for license of Project IP. IP outside defined field is market based.	Sponsor's only; no Purdue BIP is included.	No Purdue BIP. There may be sponsor BIP but it isn't exploited to generate Project IP.
