

NOTICE TO FOOD AND DRUG
ADMINISTRATION
CONTRACTORS/GRANTEES REGARDING
POTENTIAL GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN
February 8, 2018

As you may be aware, the Continuing Resolution (CR) currently funding government operations ends at midnight on February 8, 2018. The Administration strongly believes that a lapse in appropriations should not occur, and that there is enough time for Congress to act to prevent a lapse. However, prudent management requires that we prepare for an orderly execution of contingency plans in the unfortunate event of a lapse.

Should a government shutdown occur, you will be advised as soon as possible about the impact to your contract/grant through a formal written notification. Please note, however, that due to the furlough status of government personnel, should a lapse occur, the contracting/grants officer may be different from the individual assigned to your contract/grant.
