IMPACTS OF A GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN

For Grant Recipients:

The government shutdown may have an impact on grantees and new grant applications or proposals. New grants and cooperative agreements will not be awarded during a government shutdown.

Any active grant awards and cooperative agreements with obligated funds should continue approved project activities during the government shutdown.

During a shutdown, OMB may not allow federal agencies to process amendments, payments, monitor, administer, or engage in any other grant management activities.

For Program Managers:

The government shutdown may have an impact on grantees and new grant applications or proposals. New grants and cooperative agreements will not be awarded during a government shutdown.

Any active grant awards and cooperative agreements with obligated funds should continue approved project activities during the government shutdown.

Grant applicants who have not yet submitted an application or proposal may continue to send in a new application or proposal during the shutdown, but due to the limited number of federal agency staff available, should expect a longer review process. Likewise, new grant applicants who are undergoing the evaluation and negotiation of terms of their award, should expect a pause in evaluations and negotiations during the government shutdown.

During a shutdown, OMB may not allow federal agencies to process amendments, payments, monitor, administer, or engage in any other grant management activities.
