Protect Purdue:

- Tracking of COVID - surveillance testing is going well and compliance is great. Faculty staff and students are really doing their part. Campus vaccination rate overall is 88%; students are at 88%; faculty at 94%; and staff at 83%. These rates are helping to keep positivity rate low. Employees are able to remove masks when working out.
- Pfizer boosters are available on campus. Will be able to vaccinate children ages 1-5 soon; watch *Purdue Today*.
