Empty Containers
(take the lid off and throw in the trash)
Latex Paint
(unless lead is listed as ingredient)

How do I dry latex paint for proper disposal?

Clean up with soap and water. Pour clay-based cat litter or oil dry in the paint can using a 1:1 ratio. It will dry in a day or two. Leave the lid off and set out with the regular trash.
