

### Undergraduate Enrollment


#### West Lafayette - Fall 2021 Undergraduate Enrollment Projection






#### West Lafayette - Projected Enrollment for Summer & Fall 2021


#### West Lafayette - New Beginner Average SAT & ACT Combined





### High School GPA


#### West Lafayette - New Beginner Average High School GPA


#### West Lafayette - Year-to-Date Overall Selectivity of 68.7%



# YTD New Beginner Accepts by Gender


West Lafayette - 41.8% Female New Freshman Accepts as of Early May
