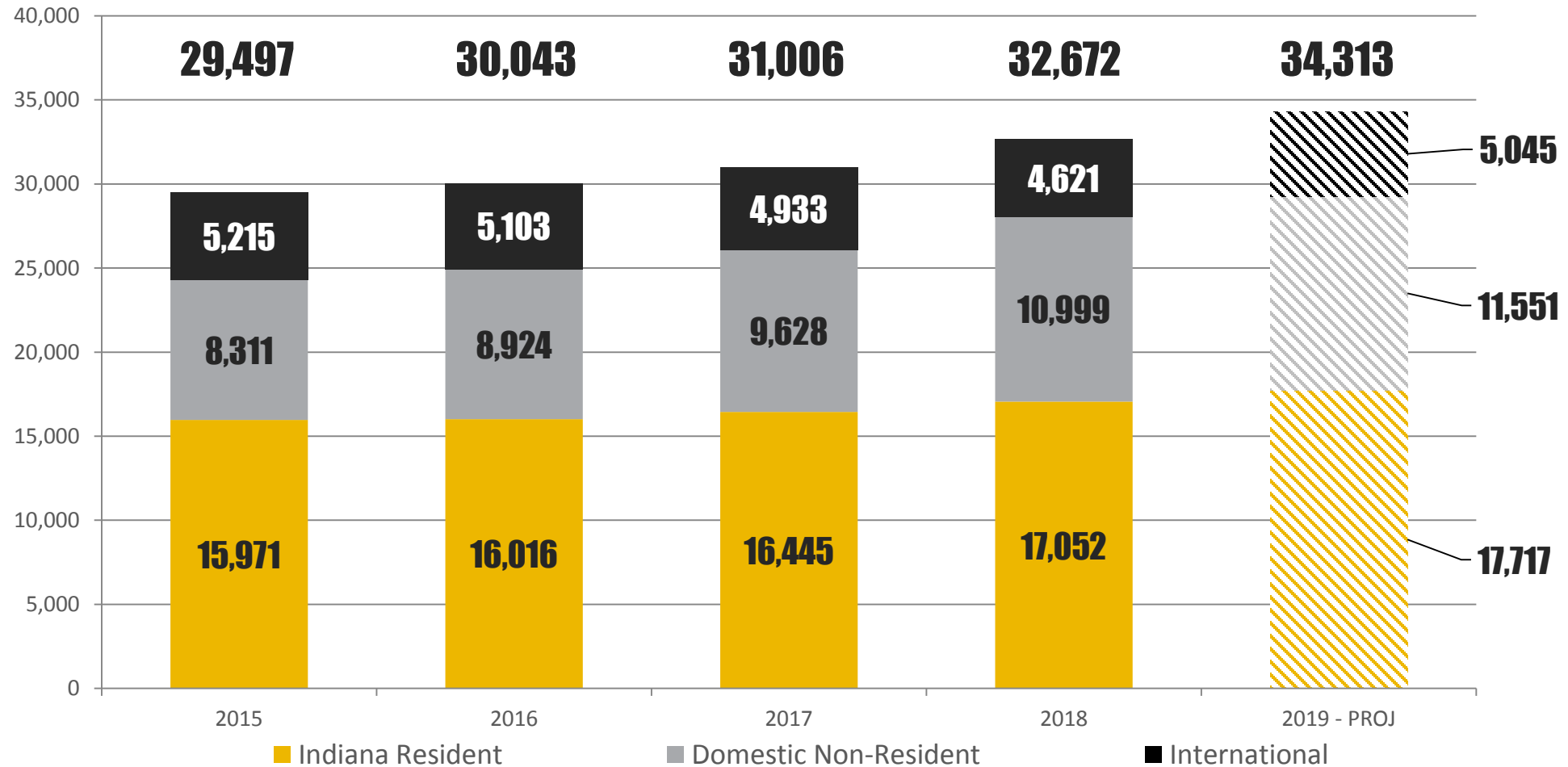

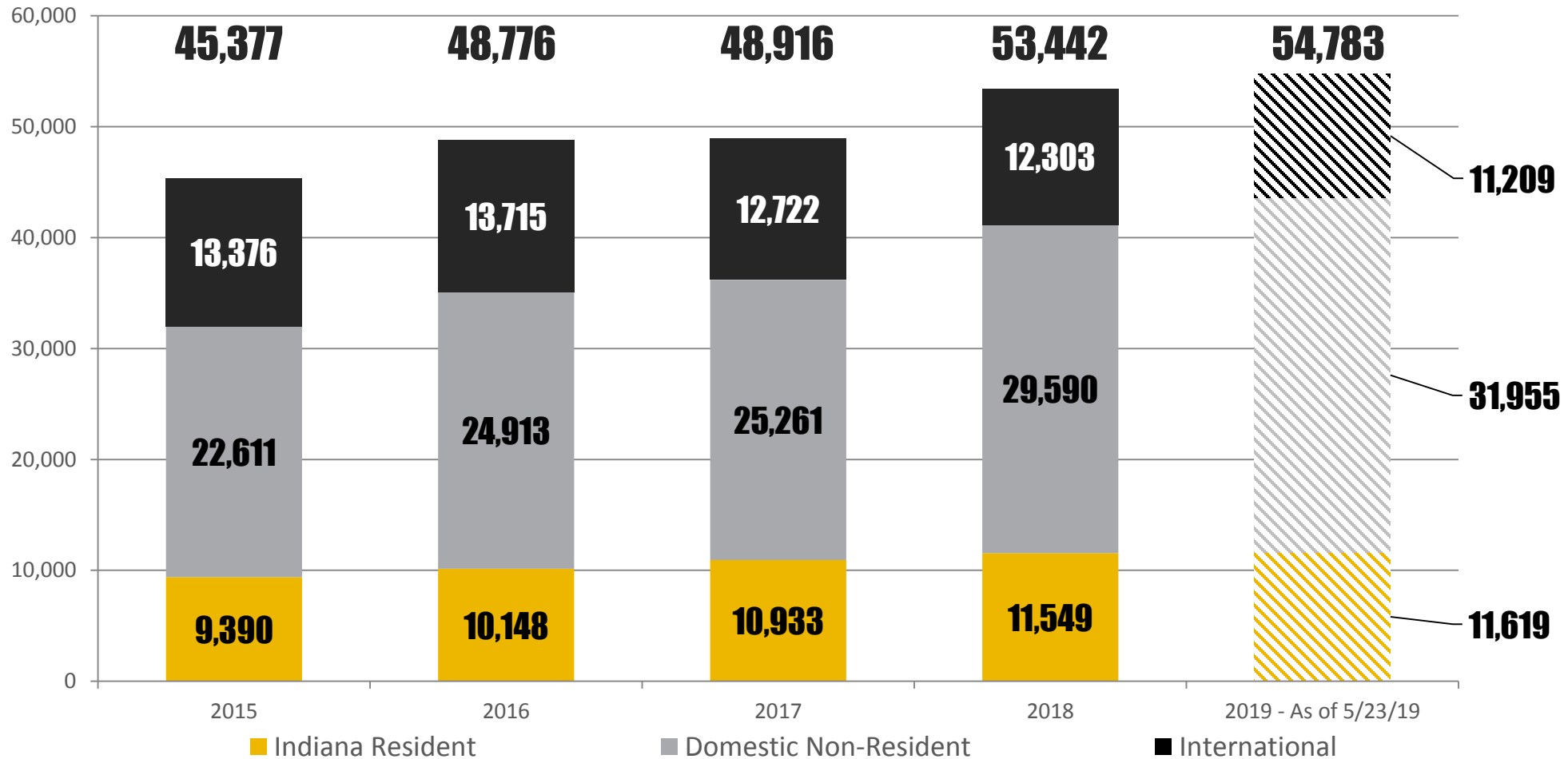
# UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT BY RESIDENCY

## WEST LAFAYETTE – FALL 2019 UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT PROJECTION



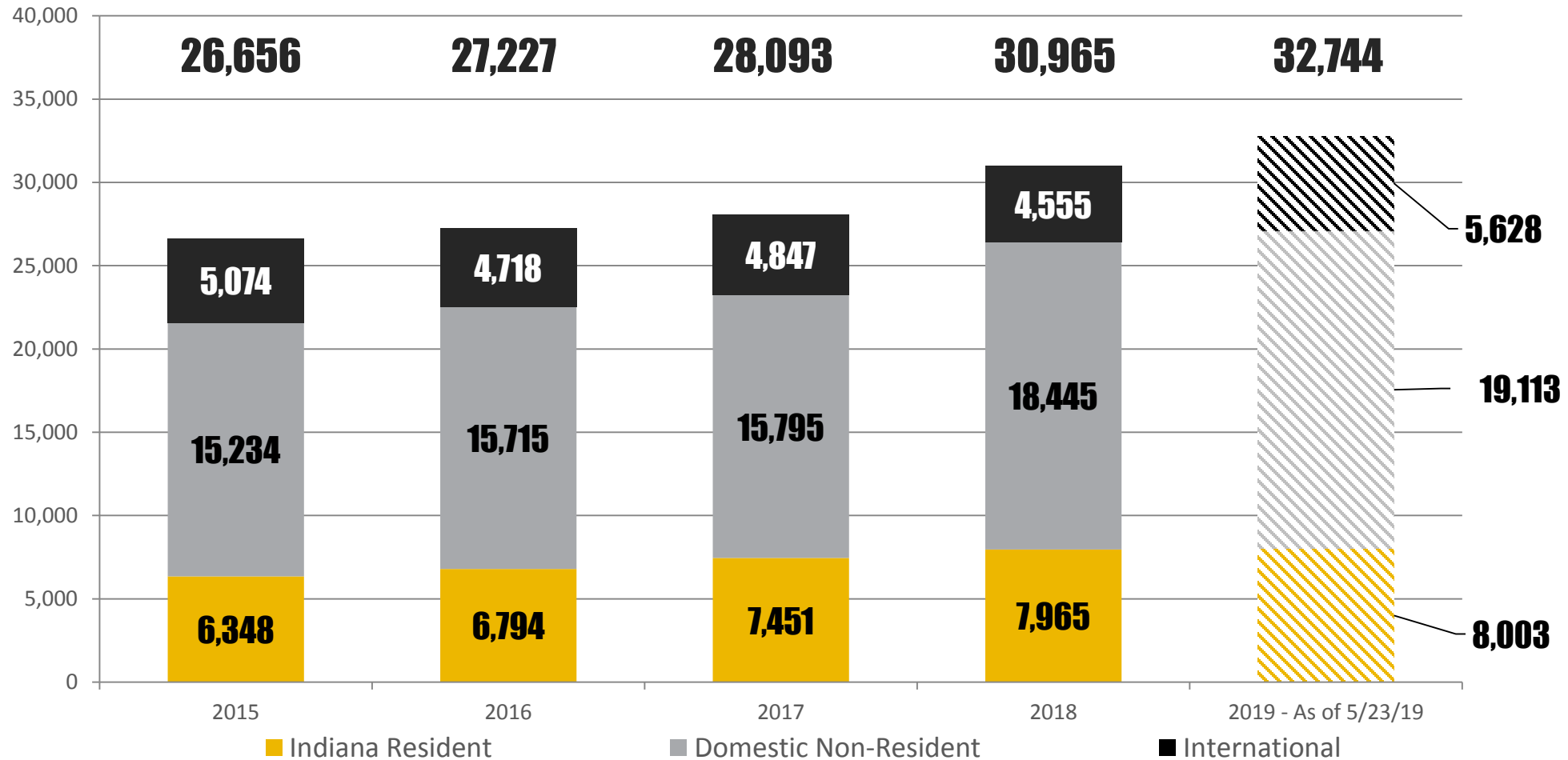

## WEST LAFAYETTE – 2019 TO DATE



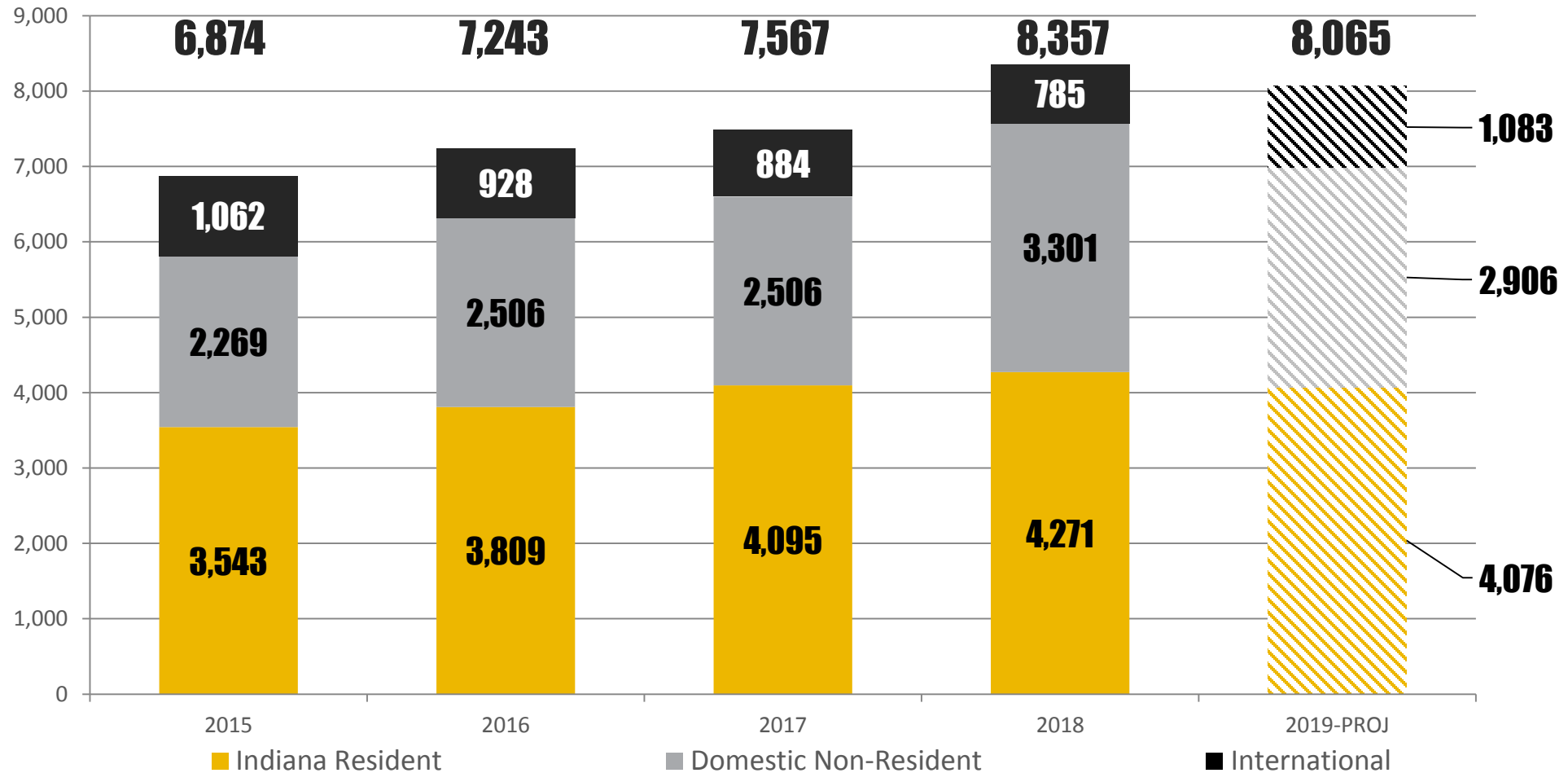

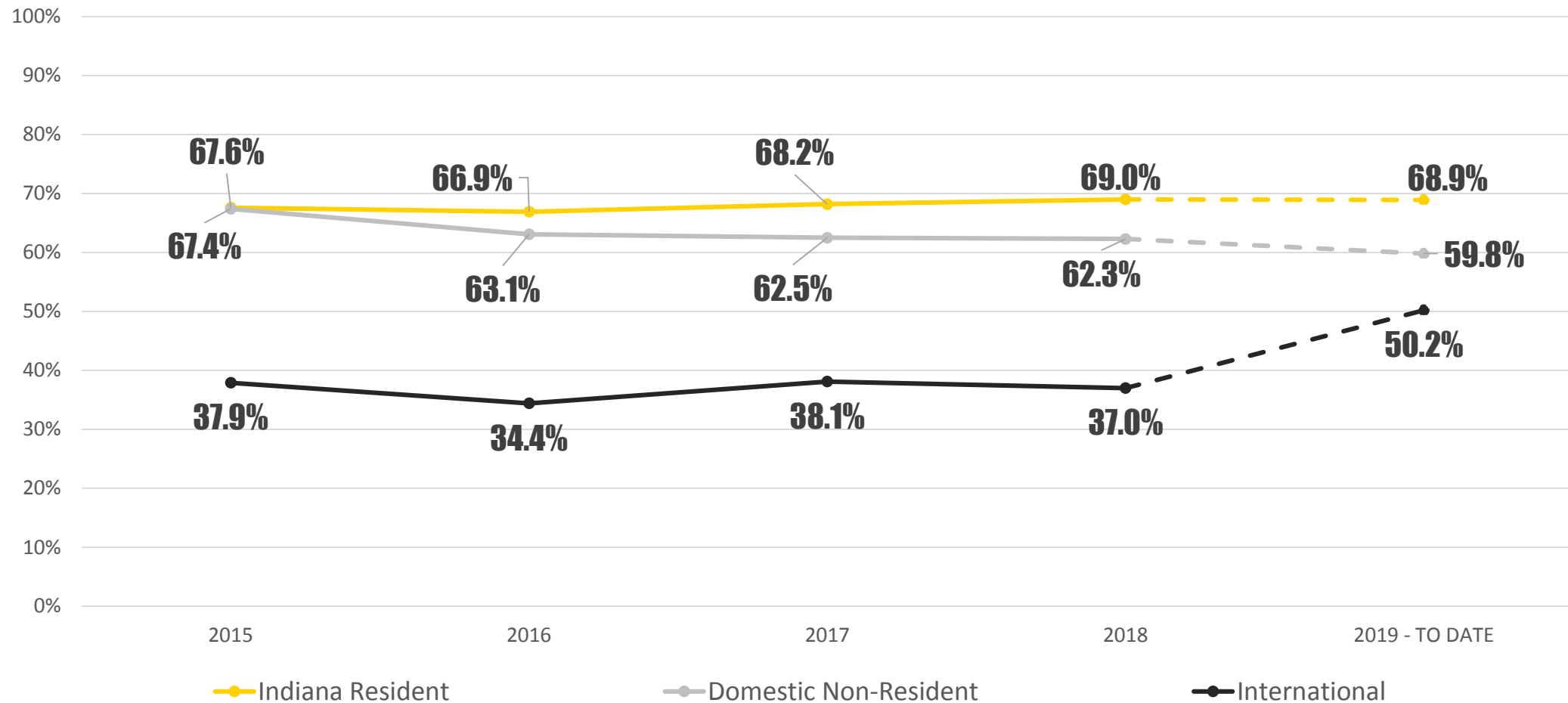

## WEST LAFAYETTE – PROJECTED ENROLLMENT FOR SUMMER + FALL 2019



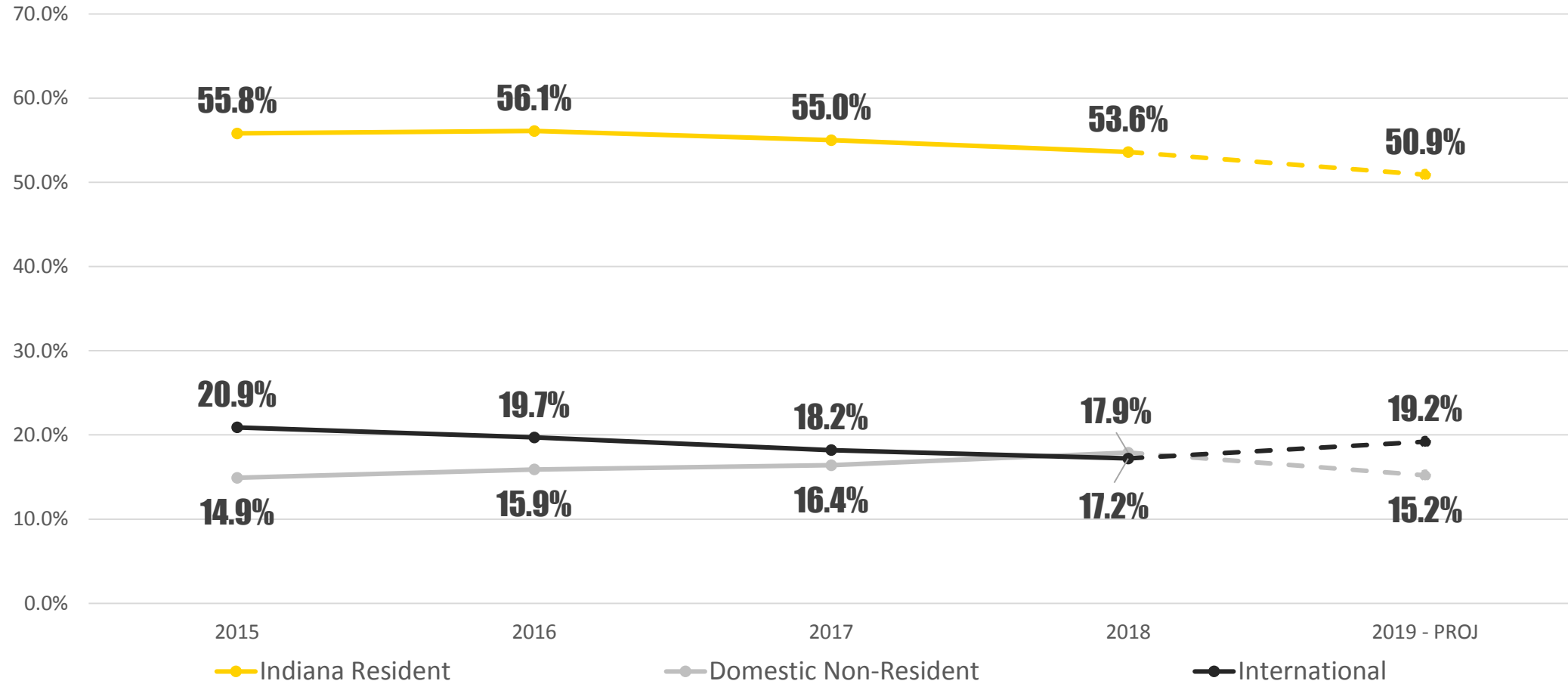
# SELECTIVITY – ADMISSIONS/APPLICATIONS

WEST LAFAYETTE – APPROXIMATE OVERALL SELECTIVITY OF 59.8%



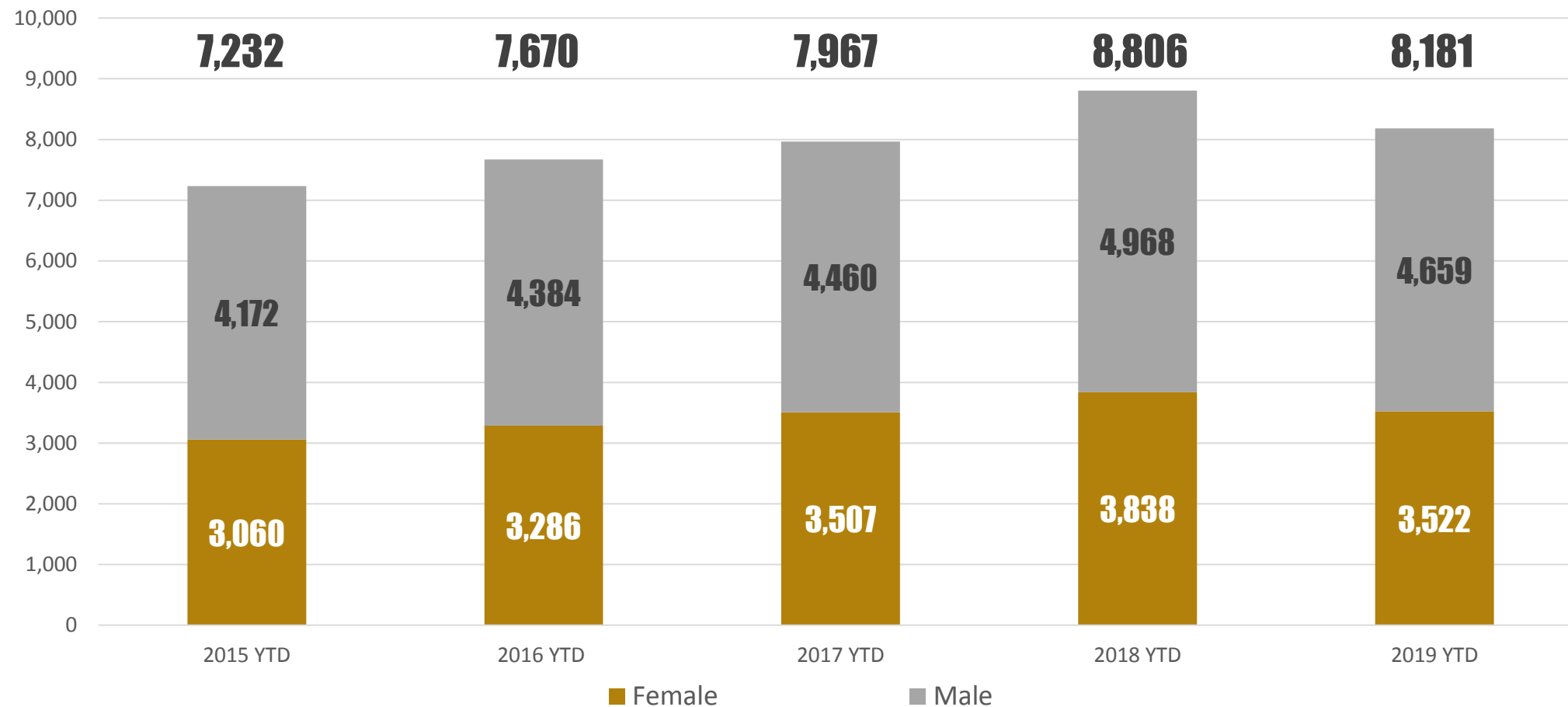
# YIELD – ENROLLED/ADMISSIONS

# YTD NEW BEGINNER ACCEPTS BY GENDER

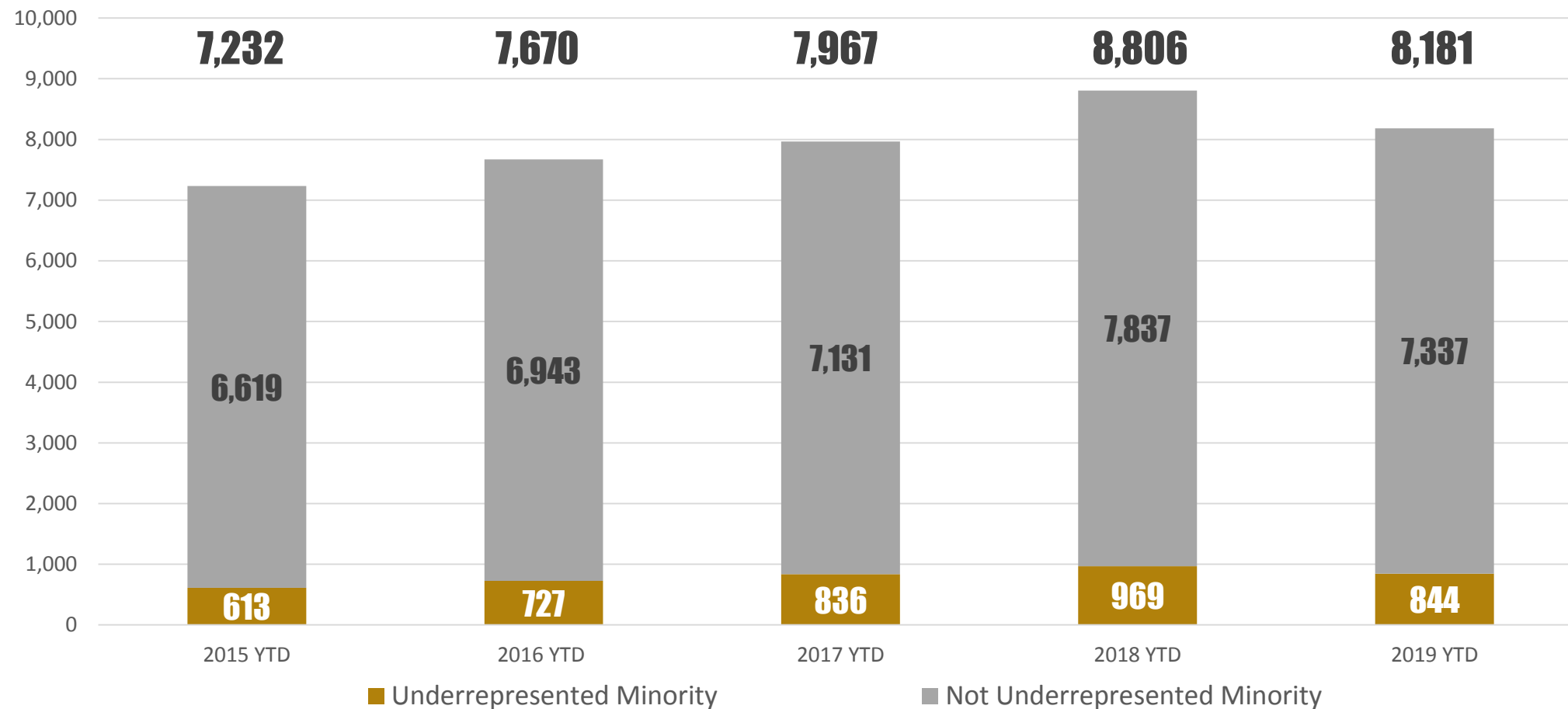
WEST LAFAYETTE – 43.1% FEMALE NEW FRESHMAN ACCEPTS AS OF EARLY MAY
