



# **SUMMER QUICK FACTS**

- More than 700 unique courses for Summer 2018
  - Around 300 online courses
- 100 and 200 level courses account for roughly 65% of course enrollments
- Approximately 50% Indiana residents
- 14% transfer students compared to 10% Fall/Spring
- Approximately 13% of students are retaking courses




# WHY TAKE SUMMER COURSES?

- More than 1,200 students graduate each summer
- 60% of students who graduate in 4 years or less have completed at least 1 summer course (OIRAE)
- Students net an average of \$20,870 when graduating one semester early (OIRAE)
- Get ahead to focus on difficult coursework during future semesters
- Diversify one's education
