Subject: Statement about the Use of AI in Each Particular Course

Rationale: The employment of AI and related resources is quite widespread in

> academic situations at Purdue, but is not always addressed specifically. It is important for students to know the limits of

acceptance of AI in the work that they produce, and fair for students to know what part of the grading might be performed by AI. This

should be made clear at the outset of any class.

Proposal: Each instructor must have a syllabus statement of parameters and

> boundaries for the use of Artificial Intelligence (or similar) in each course, whether for student content generation, instructor grading,

or any other purposes.
