

FSCL Crisis Response Outline

ACT

Call all emergency numbers, **911**, so the appropriate emergency personnel can respond.

The president (or highest ranking officer) should take charge of the situation.

Cooperate fully with the needs of any public safety organization seeking to help you or protect your safety

SECURE

Restrict access to the area/house at once for the protection of others.

Make note of who is in the area. Limit access to members and emergency responders.

Assign someone to calmly monitor the secluded space.

Do not tamper with any part of the area involved in the incident specifically which might be construed as evidence or involved with the incident.

NOTIFY

Be sure to make contact with advisors ASAP. Including but not limited to the chapter/house advisor, national office, and FSCL

FOLLOW UP

Request necessary support services from the University or HQ.
