CALENDAR PLANNING - SPRING 2023

Effective calendar planning is an incredible predictor of success for your organization. Check out all the ways calendar planning can help your organization:

How does it help?

- Decreases stress around logistics, since you have enough time to
- explore options.
- Allows officers in charge to manage their time effectively
- Creates expectations for members around attendance
- Helps visualize the flow of the semester
- Serves as an excellent officer transition activity

Tips for calendar planning:

- Include dates to avoid:
 - University breaks, Spring Break is the week of March 13th
 - Major sporting events like Purdue Men's Basketball
 - FSCL Events (see the insert below)
- Consider programming goals AND the influence of weather
 - Community Service (Indoor and Outdoor Options)
 - Philanthropy Events
 - Bonding activities and membership education
- Remember Education Requirements (from your Organization or Sanctions)
 - Consider deadlines for completion
 - Provide your guest speaker/educator with a number of date options, or enough notice if your date is specific.
- Provide a calendar to members of firm event dates as soon as possible


