

Diversity, Equity and Inclusion: Student Development Funding Opportunity

College of Health and Human Sciences

The purpose of this funding opportunity is to support participation in trainings, workshops and other learning opportunities that contribute to College of Health and Human Science (HHS) students' development of knowledge and ability to foster and champion diversity, equity and inclusion in their social, academic, or work environments. Participation in the relevant program should build individual skill and capacity for being active agents of change and social justice advocates. An example is the ACLU's [College and Community Program](#). The funding opportunity is open to all HHS students. Undergraduate student applications will be considered separately from Masters and Doctoral level student applications. Each recipient will receive funding to cover up to \$350 of expenses associated with attendance at the event, such as event registration, travel or lodging.

Eligibility

Any HHS student may apply who is attending a training, workshop or other learning opportunity that will build their knowledge and capacity to be active agents in fostering diversity, equity and inclusion if the following eligibility requirements are met:

1. Applicants must be enrolled in a degree-seeking program within the College of HHS at Purdue University to be considered for this funding opportunity.
2. Applicants may only submit one application per year. The funding may only be applied to the stated program.
3. Priority will be given to students who have not previously received this funding.
4. For graduate students, this funding may not be used for attendance at all or part of an academic conference in a graduate student's discipline. (The Compton Graduate Travel Award is more appropriate for such conference attendance.)

Deadline

Applications will be considered from the beginning of the academic year to the beginning of the next academic year and may be submitted at any time.

Responsibilities

Should you receive this funding, you will be required to provide documentation of and receipts for your expenses (e.g., registration, lodging, travel). In addition, recipients will prepare a brief summary of what they found most important and helpful for dissemination purposes (e.g., posted on HHS Diversity, Equity and Inclusion website).
