

Intern Identified Supervised Practice

The ISPP intern is responsible for locating all of his/her preceptors and practice sites for all rotations. As part of the application process, the applicant must secure his/her MNT II preceptor and practice site. All practice sites must be located in the state of Indiana. The Dietetics Program Manager will offer resources and advice to the intern for recruiting potential preceptors if needed. The DPD Director and/or Dietetics Program Manager ensures that adequate learning opportunities are available at a practice site for the intern to achieve and master required competencies prior to approving the site. Questions about the suitability of a practice site for a particular rotation may be referred to the Dietetics Program Manager at any time. Potential preceptors are also encouraged to contact the Dietetics Program Manager prior to agreeing to host an ISPP intern to clarify expectations and to discuss potential learning opportunities.

Many hospitals and healthcare facilities are closely affiliated with religious organizations. If an intern is not comfortable completing supervised practice in a facility due to religious reasons, the intern needs to take this into account and find another suitable facility.
