

Do you have aphasia?

Participate in Free Language Treatment Study!

Purpose:

Persons with aphasia are invited to participate in a virtual language treatment study. Aphasia is a language disorder, frequently caused by a stroke, that can affect speaking, understanding others, reading and/or writing. We are seeking participants with aphasia who want to improve their ability to talk in sentences.

What's involved?

- Initial language evaluation to determine eligibility.
- If eligible, participants will receive up to 15 treatment sessions.
- Total study duration is 4-5 months.
- Sessions will be delivered in-person or remotely.

Who's eligible?

To be eligible, you should:

- Have aphasia as a result of stroke.
- Be a native speaker of English.
- Have access to stable internet and a laptop.
