HLA BOWLING TEAM THIS WEEK

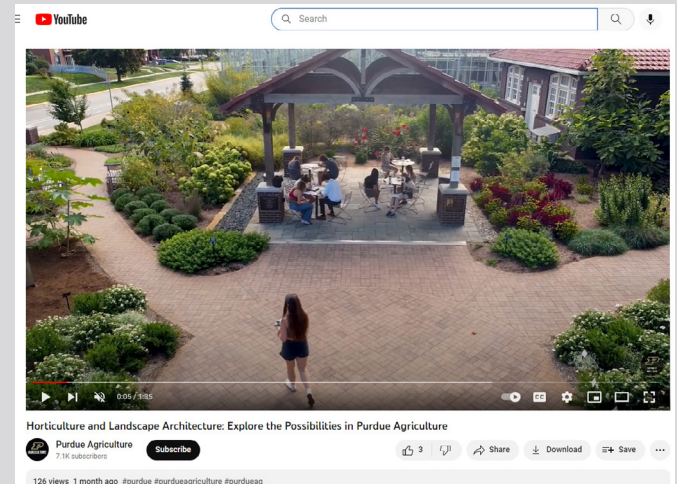

Assistant Professor **Yiwei Huang** has been selected once again as one of the faculty Research Fellows of the Landscape Architecture Foundation (LAF) [Case Study Investigation \(CSI\) program](#). The CSI program is a unique research collaboration and training program for faculty, students, and practitioners. LAF funded faculty-student research teams work with designers to document the environmental, social, and economic impacts of exemplary, high-performing landscape projects. This time, Huang will cooperate with Rundell Ernstberger Associates Indianapolis Office, and investigate the landscape performances of Monon Boulevard and Midtown Plaza in Carmel, Indiana.
