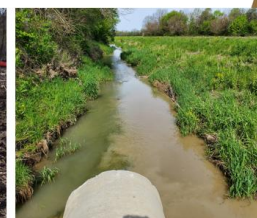

Concluding a construction project requires steps that must be taken in order to ensure the project site is no longer at risk of causing stormwater pollution or sediment discharges. The site must be permanently stabilized, construction activities complete, and post-construction best management practices (BMPs) installed. Module 11 is intended for a general construction stormwater audience, but may be especially beneficial for individuals involved in implementing stormwater pollution prevention plans or self monitoring programs.

Module 11 covers the final inspection process, including confirming stabilization and the transition of temporary stormwater management measures to permanent measures. It details the Notice of Termination (NOT) process and financial considerations such as releasing performance bonds and transferring post-construction BMP responsibilities to the new owner.



Learning Objectives of Training Module 11:

1. Review the items that need to be complete to be eligible to terminate permit coverage.
2. Recognize tools that an MS4 may use to ensure project completion.
3. Understand the transition from construction phase to the post-construction phase.
