Module 8: Self Monitoring Program & The Project Management Log









To ensure construction stormwater practices are functioning properly, being maintained correctly, and are adequate for current project site conditions, regular site evaluations must occur throughout the duration of the construction project. Related documentation must also be maintained. Module 8 is intended for a general construction stormwater audience, but may be especially beneficial for individuals conducting self monitoring inspections and stormwater pollution prevention plan (SWPPP) implementation.

Module 8 covers the Self-Monitoring Program (SMP), including inspection frequency, inspector responsibilities, and the purpose of the SMP. The module also outlines the Project Management Log (PML), detailing SWPPP updates, off-site material locations, compliance documentation, and various implementation options.
