Fulbright U.S. Student Program Overview & Alumni Panel

This Fulbright-run interactive session is an ideal way to learn straight from the source and to hear from former Boilermakers who received Fulbright grants. The discussion will provide a broad overview of the Fulbright U.S. Student Program, meaning basic information for anyone wanting to learn more about the Fulbright U.S. Student Program. This includes those considering a Fulbright down the line (Freshmen, Sophomores, early graduate students) as well as those considering applying now. Details about the 2024-25 application processes will be shared in grant specific sessions throughout the week.

2024-25 English Teaching Assistant Grants

Excited by the prospect of putting your tutoring, teaching, or mentoring experience to use teaching English in another country? English Teaching Assistants also serve as U.S. cultural ambassadors. Session for applicants aiming to be abroad in 2024-25. Juniors, seniors, recent alumni, and graduate students apply.

2024-25 Research and Study Grants

Apply to fund independent research or study in a foreign country during 2024-25. Learn the details of the application process and how Fulbright can best meet your needs. Juniors, seniors, recent alumni, and graduate students apply.

Fulbright for STEM Majors

STEM undergraduate students – wondering how a Fulbright year can fit into your study and professional goals? Whether considering a Fulbright between graduation and your next step or looking to conduct research abroad for your thesis/dissertation in graduate school, begin positioning your qualifications, research, and “cultural exchange” aspirations now. The basic information shared at this session will overlap with the grant specific sessions just without the specific discussion of STEM challenges and benefits, thus if you can’t attend this time, those are a reasonable alternative.

2024-25 Fulbright for Graduate Students

Ph.D. and Master’s students: Join us to discuss applying for grants to fund independent research or teaching English abroad during 2024-25. This grant can also fit into a secondary degree from an institution abroad. The basic information shared at this session will overlap with the grant specific sessions just without the specific discussion of graduate student challenges and benefits, thus if you can’t attend this time, those are a reasonable alternative.

Fulbright for Polytechnic Students

PPI undergraduate students - Join us to consider how post-bac time abroad can help prepare you for a career in a technology-driven field. Be it conducting research, teaching English, or pursuing an advanced degree, Fulbright can work for you! The basic information shared at this session will overlap with the grant specific sessions, just without the specific discussion of why a PPI student might want to pursue Fulbright in particular, thus if you can’t attend this time, those are a reasonable alternative.

Fulbright Scholar Grants
