Professional School Mock Interview

If you have received an invitation to interview with a professional school, you may schedule a mock interview with the Center for Career Opportunities. Follow these steps to schedule the interview:

- 1. Current students must complete a practice interview using Big Interview. https://purdue.biginterview.com/
- 2. Call the CCO at 765-494-3981.
- 3. Ask to schedule a 60-minute professional school mock interview. Provide your name, email address and the interview type (medical school, dental school, etc.)
- 4. Dress in interview attire for the mock interview, unless you are coming directly from the lab where you are not allowed to wear interview attire.
- 5. Check in with the receptionist in room 132, Young Hall.
- 6. Be prepared to answer questions regarding why you want to go into your chosen field, your

clinical/healthcare experiences, and meaningful campus or community activities.

Diligence Lab

Many employers and professional schools take social media profiles into account when making hiring and admissions decisions. Social media analysis powered by Diligence Lab is a free service offered to Purdue University students. This platform scans your social media posts for potentially harmful or distasteful content that could be a red flag to employers or admissions officers. To access Diligence Lab, login to your myCCO account and look for the quick link on the right hand side under "Job Search Preparation."
