Professional School Mock Interview

If you have received an invitation to interview with a professional school, you may schedule a mock interview with the Center for Career Opportunities. Follow these steps to schedule the interview:

1. Complete a practice interview using Big Interview. <https://purdue.biginterview.com/>
2. Call the CCO at 765-494-3981.
3. Ask to schedule a professional school mock interview. Provide your name, email address and the interview type (medical school, dental school, etc.)
4. Dress in interview attire for the mock interview, unless you are coming directly from the lab where you are not allowed to wear interview attire.
5. Check in with the receptionist in room 132, Young Hall.
6. Be prepared to answer questions regarding why you want to go into your chosen field, your clinical/healthcare experiences, and meaningful campus or community activities.
