Summer Opportunities

University of Detroit Mercy School of Dentistry Summer Enrichment Program: This program assists underrepresented minority students interested in gaining admission to dental school and pursuing careers in dentistry.

University of Michigan SMART program: 10-week long program designed for undergrads interested in a combined MD/PhD degree leading to a career in academic medicine. UM-SMART research fellows work full-time in a basic research lab under the mentorship of a research faculty member. In addition, students receive a stipend of \$4400, housing and meal allowance. Shadowing, MCAT preparation materials, oral and poster presentation and seminars, mentoring program and MSTP scientific retreat are also included. Application deadline is January 17, 2020.
