2023 Pre-Professional Advising Letter Service

Pre-Professional Advising offers a letter service for applicants to medical or dental school. We collect recommendation letters and submit a letter packet to the application service. We maintain the letters on file for five years should you need to reapply. If you are applying to medical or dental school in the summer of 2023 to begin a program in the fall of 2024, now is the time to sign up for the letter service. **To sign up, complete the 2023 Pre-Professional Advising Letter Service survey**. After you sign up, you will receive an email from our office with a handout to give to your letter writers.

If you are an applicant to other health fields such as optometry, physician assistant, occupational or physical therapy, veterinary medicine, etc. we are not able to collect or submit letters of evaluation on your behalf. The application systems for other fields do not allow us to submit letters on behalf of the writers. Pre-Professional Advising has created two handouts to assist you through the process of requesting letters: Requesting Letters of Evaluation and Pre-Health Letter of Evaluation Writer's Guide.

Summer Opportunities

Summer Health Professions Education Program

The <u>Summer Health Professions Education Program</u> (SHPEP) is a FREE, six-week transformative enrichment program for high school and college students interested in the health professions. SHPEP's goal is to strengthen academic proficiency and career development of students underrepresented in the health professions and to prepare them for successful application and matriculation to health professions schools. In addition to dentistry and medicine, the program offers opportunities to explore nursing, optometry, pharmacy, physical therapy and public health. The deadline to apply is February 5, 2023.

Eye U @ Indiana University College Summer Program

Over the course of three days (July 17-20, 2023), you will learn about the optometry application process, participate in labs and lectures with some of the optical world's brightest researchers, and get to know the city of Bloomington with fun events around town. Students will be introduced to current faculty and students and hear firsthand about their journey through optometry school. By attending this camp, you will connect

with the IUSO Office of Student Administration and benefit from our support now and in the future. Plus, you will receive a tour of the optometry school, including our optical research labs, our new laser lab and the Atwater Eye Care Center, IU's own public eye care clinic. VCU Summer Academic Enrichment Program

Summer Academic Enrichment Program (SAEP) is a six-week summer program that simulates the first year of dentistry, medicine, pharmacy or physical therapy professional school instruction. Participants take academically intensive instruction in each of their chosen tracks in addition to non-credit core-coursework in virtual anatomy (head and neck), pharmacology, and physiology. SAEP participants attend learning skills and test-taking workshops, mock interviews, professionalism seminars, current healthcare topics, coaching, and community service activities in an interprofessional framework. Any current college junior, senior, graduate and post-baccalaureate student who is preparing to apply to a graduate/professional dentistry, medicine, pharmacy or physical therapy program is eligible to participate. Early decision application deadline is February 1, 2023, and regular decision application deadline is March 15, 2023. For more information and to apply visit the SAEP webpage.

VCU Allied Health Career Exploration Program

Allied Health Career Exploration (AHCE) is a two-week summer residential program for students interested in any of the nine health career programs offered by the VCU College of Health Professions. Participants meet throughout the week for full-day department/degree program admissions information, hands-on and immersive activities within each discipline, workshops on current healthcare topics, interviewing skills, resume development, and more. Additionally, AHCE participants receive the necessary information to pursue a VCU College of Health Professions application process. Any rising or current college freshmen, sophomores, and juniors who are interested in patient counseling, medical laboratory sciences, physical therapy, occupational therapy, nurse anesthesia, rehabilitation counseling, radiation sciences, health administration, and gerontology as a potential healthcare career are eligible to participate. Early decision application deadline is February 1, 2023, and regular decision application deadline is April 1, 2023. For more information and to apply, visit the AHCE webpage.
