#### **AccessLex Resources for Pre-Law Students**

## **Harvard Law School Junior Deferral Program**

Students who know they want to go to law school but have an interest in exploring other professional, educational, or service opportunities first should consider applying to the <a href="Harvard Law School Junior Deferral Program">Harvard Law School Junior Deferral Program</a>. Through the program, students apply (free of cost) to HLS as a college junior. If admitted, students must commit to defer their offer of admission for a minimum of two years once they've completed their undergraduate degree. They can then use this deferral period to explore their interests and gain hands-on work experience before returning to the law school classroom. A <a href="wirtual information session">wirtual information</a> session will be held on April 5, 2022. The deadline to apply is July 1, 2022.

## LexScholars by AccessLex

The 2022 application cycle for <a href="LexScholars by AccessLex">LexScholars</a> is a diversity pipeline initiative premised on helping aspiring law students from underrepresented racial, ethnic and socioeconomic backgrounds get into law school. It is primarily focused on students with the potential to succeed in law school who feel their test scores might hold them back from admission. Acceptance into LexScholars is offered on a first-come, first-selected basis so, apply as soon as possible! The RISE Summer Academy is a six-week intensive program for American Indians / Alaskan Natives that provides in-depth training and Indigenous learning opportunities to prepare scholars for the medical school application

### 2022 AIAN Medical School Application Workshop

The Northwest Native American Center of Excellence is excited to announce the 2022 American Indian/Alaska Native Medical School Application Workshop in collaboration with Oregon Health and Sciences University, Washington State University, University of Washington, and U.C. Davis School of Medicine. The workshop will be held virtually on Friday, May 6, 2022.

This workshop will comprehensively review the medical school admissions process, including: 1) practical tips for writing your personal statement and a 1:1 live feedback session, 2) requesting letters of recommendation, 3) mock medical school interviews in MMI and traditional formats, and 4) helpful tips for navigating the application process.
