

#3 - Purdue Elements: Automatic Claiming User Guide

Elements automatically harvests information about faculty's scholarly works and grants from an extensive range of academic and scientific data sources.

To set up your automatic claiming, click on the three bars at the top left of the home page:



Select the "My Profile" tab, then under "Settings," select "Automatic Claiming."

Clicking on "Automatic Claiming" will take you to the following page:





Claiming Author Identifiers

Elements will suggest author identifiers based on your name-based search settings, including identifiers from ORCID, Dimensions, Web of Science, Scopus, arXiv, figshare, SSRN and others.

Approve or reject the identifiers using the Yes and No buttons (you can also choose the Ignore option).

Elements will automatically retrieve publications in databases using these identifiers and place them in the "Mine", "Not Mine" or "Ignored" folders based on "Yes", "No" or "Ignore" being selected.



If you select "Yes", a menu with the following two choices will pop up:

- 1) Auto claim associated items Select this option if this identifier always identifies you, and you want to claim all publications that contain it.
- 2) Auto suggest associated items Select this option if the identifier sometimes identifies you, or when you prefer to manually claim or reject publications.

If you select "No" or "Ignore," a menu with the following two choices will pop up:

- 1) Auto reject associated items Select this option if this identifier <u>never</u> identifies you. This is especially useful if you are incorrectly offered identifiers belonging to others with similar names or identifiers belonging to frequent collaborators.
- 2) Ignore this identifier Select this option if you do not want this identifier to factor into what publications are harvested. You may still be offered publications through the name-based search that contain this identifier.

Select "CONFIRM" to save your updates.

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Adding External Profiles

If the system does not find all your identifiers, you can enter them via the "Add external profiles" option.

- Each of the identifiers will need to be updated separately.
- If no identifiers are shown for you, additional identifiers can be added by clicking on the + icon.

A new screen will pop up and you will be given several options to choose from as to how that specific identifier will be handled.

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Adding Email Addresses

Email addresses can also be used to auto-claim publications.

- The system will automatically import the address associated with your organization. •
- Additional email addresses you may have published with previously can be added via the "Add email addresses" option.
- Once you add the email address a new screen will pop up with selection options as to how the identifier will be used, like those shown for external profile IDs.
 - Auto claim associated item
 - Auto suggest associated items
 - Ignore this email address.
- Once an email has been added as an identifier, it cannot be deleted you can edit the email address, or you change how the identifier will be used.

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Managing Email Addresses

Identifier preferences associated with each email address can be managed via the "Manage" button located in the lower right corner (or during the process of adding a new e-mail address).

- A new screen will pop up and you can select one of four options to auto claim, auto suggest, auto reject, or ignore.
 - Auto suggest setting will result in associated items to be placed in your pending list.
- As a default setting, your institutional email address is set up to be used for auto claiming of associated items.
