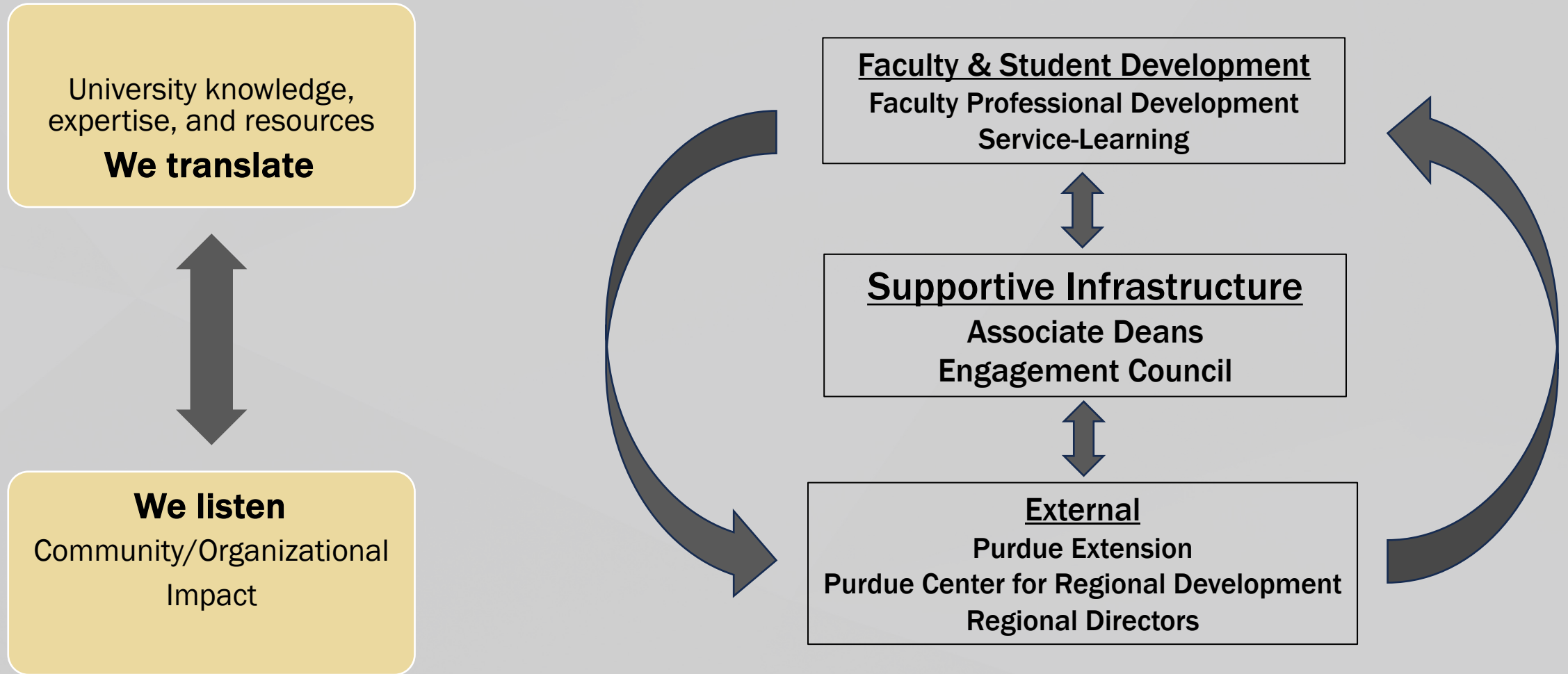

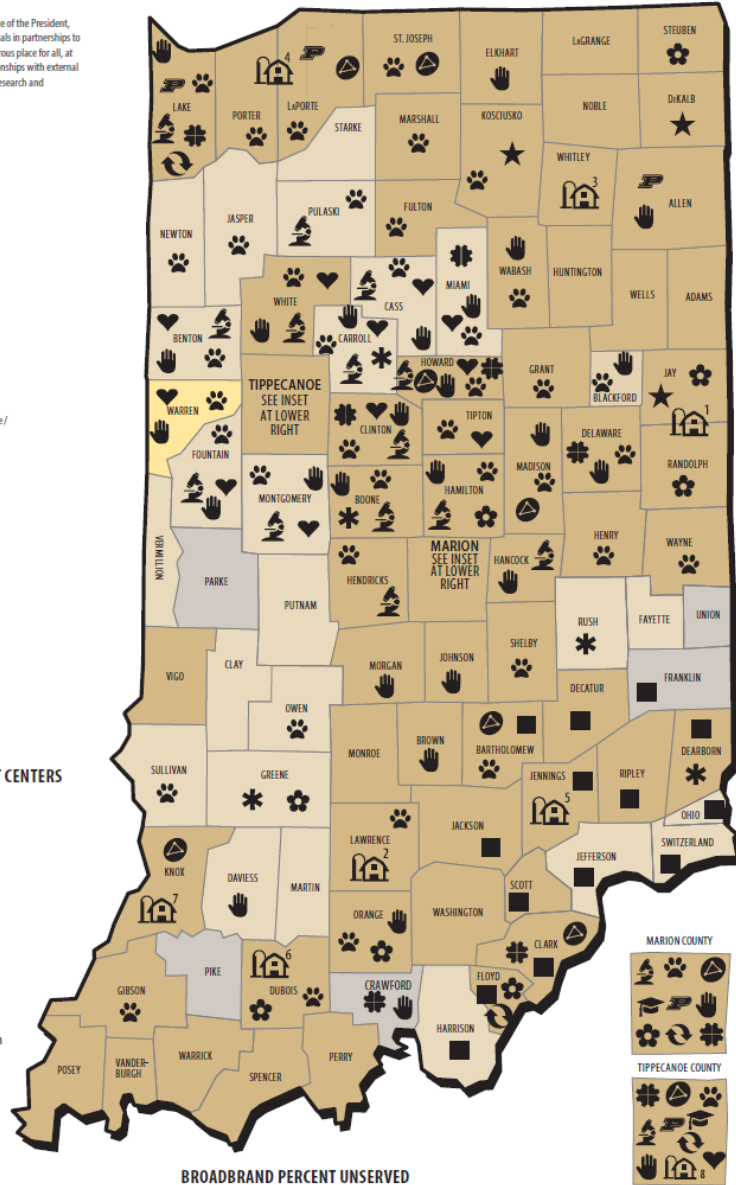

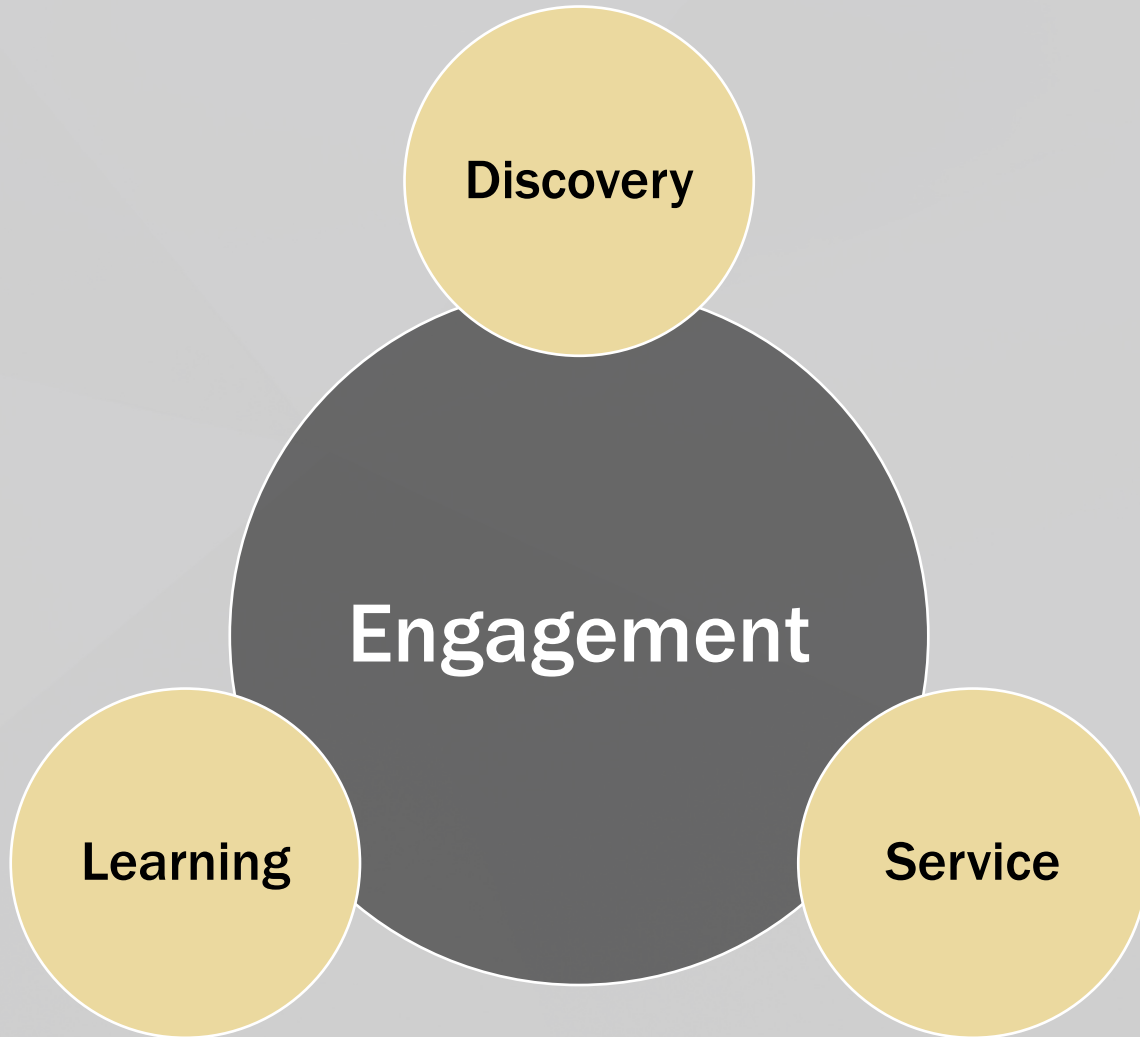
# 2023 Purdue United Way Campaign

# Scholarly Integration



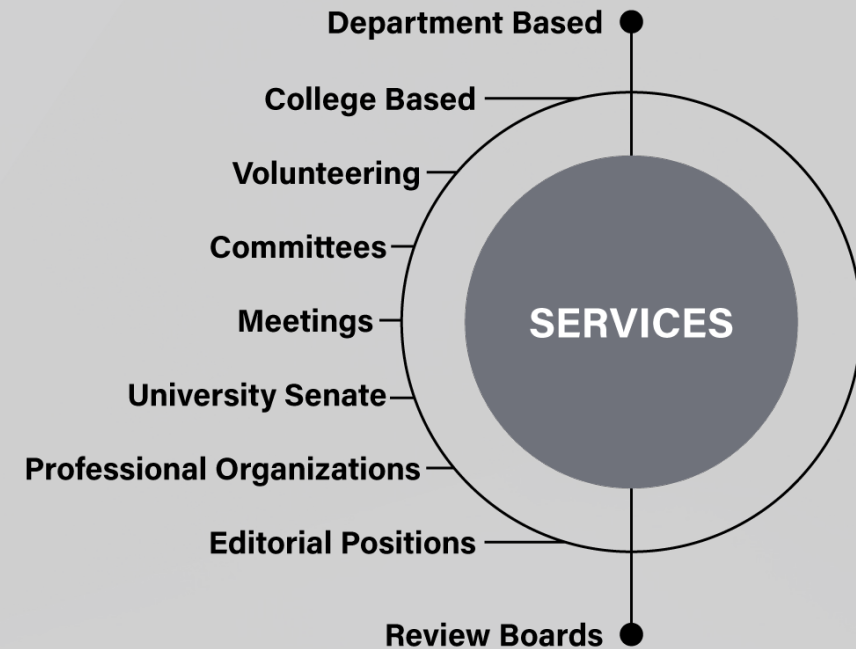
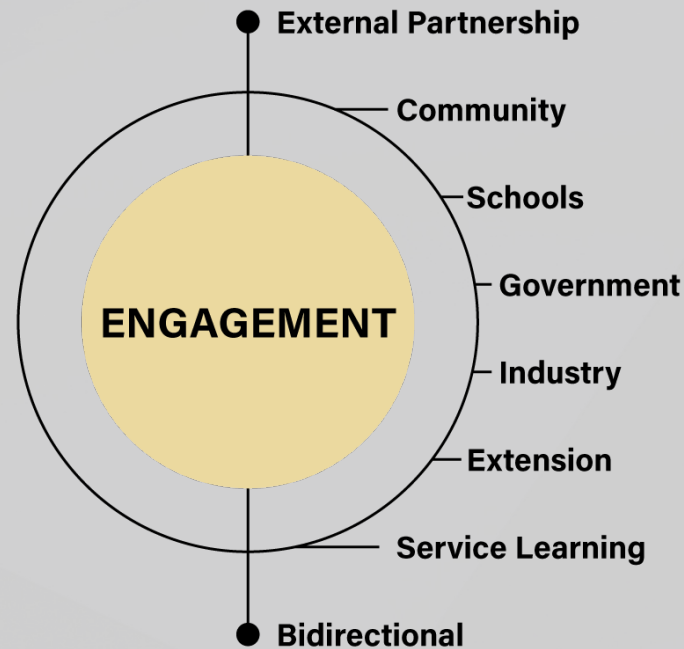

- Scholarship of engagement is distinguished from service

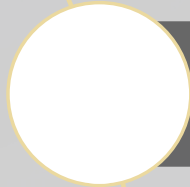




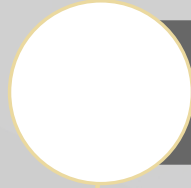
