The following disclosure is applicable to the following face-to-face licensure programs offered within the realm of education at Purdue University West Lafayette:

Applied Behavioral Analysis

Currently, there are <u>31 states</u> that have passed legislation requiring licensure to practice Behavioral Analysis. While these states vary in terms of overall requirements for licensure each state, at a minimum, will require received education from a <u>Behavior Analysis Certification Board</u> (BACB) certified program. The program at Purdue is an approved Verified Course Sequence, offering the required content to sit for the BCBA exam. However, in addition to the course content, 1500-2000 of supervised experience hours are required to sit for the certification exam. Students should investigate the individual state's rules and regulations for licensure. Please note that jurisdiction licensure or certification requirements may be affected by other factors such as teaching experience, testing requirements, and coursework.

Note that the states requiring licensure is a developing list and subject to change. Students should frequently check on the status of the state they intended to practice in should new legislation arise.

Out-of-state requirements are not concrete and subject to change with little to no warning, making it even more important for students to inquire directly to the jurisdiction of desired employment.
