Sprains, cuts, fever, flu, or other less urgent concerns, you may wish to go to a local Urgent Care Facility.

Urgent Care facilities offer:

Medical care, laboratory testing, and x-ray for illness and injury that are not life-threatening. There are fees for these services, however, they cost much less than a trip to the emergency room, and usually take less time.
