

Bioprotection Plan: Birds

Prior to arrival:

No special requirements.

Upon arrival:

Ideally, birds within a room or aviary should be all-in, all-out to prevent spread of disease.

Wild-caught birds should be healthy in appearance. Treatment for coccidiosis may be warranted if clinical signs are present. Birds brought into the indoor facilities should be treated for ectoparasites with an appropriate anti-parasitic dust.

Animal care staff should evaluate the animals as they are unpacked and if any animals are found with health issues, LAP veterinary staff should be notified.

Preventative Maintenance Plan:

Daily: Observations

Monthly: Trim beaks and/or nails monthly or as needed
