Herman Sintim, Ph.D.

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Professor Sintim obtained his BS in Medicinal Chemistry from the University College London and Ph.D. in Organic Chemistry from the University of Oxford, under the guidance of Professor David Hodgson. He performed postdoctoral research in the chemistry of natural products at the University of Oxford in the laboratory of Professor Timothy Donohoe and a second postdoctoral research in Chemical Biology investigating the rules that govern DNA replication at Stanford University in the laboratory of Professor Eric Kool. In 2006, Sintim began his independent research at the University of Maryland. In 2015, he accepted an offer to move his laboratory to Purdue University, where he now serves as the Drug Discovery Professor of Chemistry. His laboratory is located in the Center for Drug Discovery in Discovery Park. Prof. Sintim is currently a national Sigma Xi Distinguished Lecturer.
