## **The August Monthly Meeting Program – Purdue's Research Farms**

Our PURA program for August featured Jon Leuck, Director of the Purdue Agricultural Centers. He described the location and focus of the eight Purdue Agricultural Centers located across the state of Indiana. Their location is based primarily on Indiana's different soils and climate regions. Researchers use the eight Purdue Agricultural Centers (PACs) to conduct applied field crop and animal research and demonstrate cutting edge production practices and agricultural technology. There are currently over 400

“experiments” being conducted on these farms. The nearly 60 PURA retirees listening (16 via zoom) were impressed with, among other things, how technology is being widely incorporated into everyday use including drones for surveying, spraying and seeding fields and AI (artificial intelligence) incorporated for data collection on a wide range of growth, production and farm management dynamics.
