Pairing
 Activate the Bluetooth function on your phone.
 Turn on the shutter by switching the On/Off button. The shutter will enter pairing mode and the indicator LED light will flash to show it's trying to pair.
 Cilick on "AB Shutter 3" from the Bluetooth list & it should pair shortly after.
