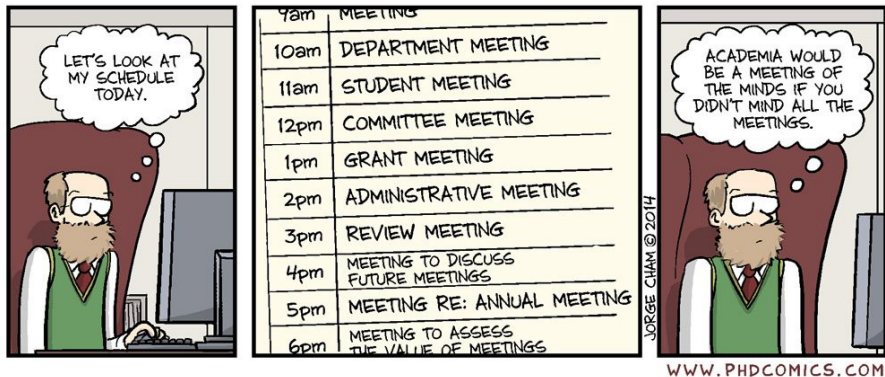

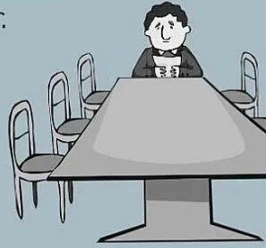

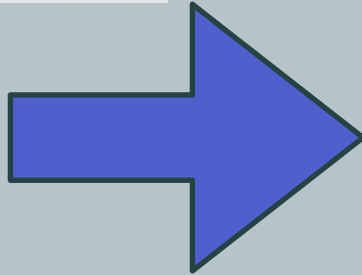

I'M ON A COMMITTEE

But what does a committee chair do?

Convenes the meetings

Shares the workload among committee members

Works with *other* committees as needed

Prepares annual reports and transition documents

ABOUT COMMITTEES

Sees members are attentive & accounted for

Couple of important Bylaws:

Bylaw 4.02: A Chairperson of a Faculty committee may request the Senate to postpone action on matters that fall within the purview of that committee. An automatic one-month postponement should be granted to the Faculty committee so it can make a recommendation. A two-thirds vote of the Senate is required to deny such a postponement.

Bylaw 5.06: Faculty committee chairs should keep their designated Senate committee chair informed of their work and provide an annual report of the committee's activities. Faculty committee chairs should work with the designated Senate committee chair in preparing proposals involving policy changes or other matters that require Senate action, using document templates available on the Senate website.
