ADA Title II Compliance / Faculty Liability

The University's Office for Civil Rights oversees compliance with ADA and Title II and will monitor progress across the university. Failure to comply may result in significant fines, penalties, and other sanctions.

Are individual faculty personally liable for external sanctions other than those originating from Purdue University?

- Answer: There is generally no legal claim for individual liability under Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act or Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, which focus on institutional compliance rather than personal liability for faculty.
