Equipment Definition -Equipment means an article of nonexpendable, tangible personal property having a useful life of more than one year and an acquisition cost of \$5,000 or more per unit.

Failure to obtain approval may result in cost disallowances.

If a fixed race is in this Agroement, it is based on an estimate of the costs for the period covered by the rate, when the actual costs for this period are determined, an adjustment will be made to a rate of a future year(s) to compensate for the difference between the couts used to establish the fixed rate and actual costs.
