Winter Session 2023 Overview

An innovative opportunity for undergraduate students to take asynchronous online classes, study abroad, or study away during the three weeks between the fall and spring semesters.

- Using *Winter Session* to stay consistent Please avoid using the terms Winter Flex or Break or January Term.
 - Winter Recess will remain in place for faculty and staff. The university will be officially closed from December 22, 2023 through January 1, 2024. The <u>wintersession@purdue.edu</u> email account will be monitored during the closure to assist with student questions.
- Class Types
 - o 3-week Undergraduate Online Courses and Study Abroad/Away
 - Students can take one 3-credit course
- Session Dates
 - o Monday, December 18, 2023 to Friday, January 5, 2024
 - Total of 11 instructional days, with university holidays not counting as instructional time

Course Registration

- Last fall: 10 guaranteed online classes were selected
- Summer: Class Scheduling until Friday, August 11
- Tuesday, September 5: Schedule of Courses and Registration Announcement
- Monday, September 11: Registration Begins
 - Students are assigned time tickets and will use Fall pin for Scheduling Assistant (except for Study Abroad/Away)
 - Each following Monday opens the next class/year <u>Registration Time Ticket Groups</u>
 - Monday, October 16: Open Registration Begins
 - No waitlist available for Winter Session
- Registrar's office will monitor drops <u>Winter 2023-2024 Drop/Add Dates</u> (Updated link)
- Academic Standing will not change after term and graduation status would move to a spring candidate

Financial Aid and Tuition and Fees

- Winter Session is attached to Spring for financial aid purposes. 202413 can't be considered a standalone term for financial aid.
- Students enrolled in Winter Session will have their Spring semester start dates changed to allow for disbursement of aid in December (starting Friday, December 8), all other students will disburse in January as usual.
- <u>Financial Aid</u> is available for Boiler Affordability Grant, Boiler Gold Grant, Purdue Promise and 21st Century Scholars, non-Study Abroad courses. Programs are only open to resident students.
- <u>Tuition and fees for Winter Session</u> are due by the first day of Spring term classes. There is no
 differential fee or administrative drop for non-payment. If a student drops or withdraws, they will be
 subject to the <u>drop/add refund percentage</u>.
