Winter Session Course Dates | Dec. 22, 2025 - Jan. 9, 2026

- 11 instructional days, with university holidays not counting as instructional time
- Monday, Dec. 22 Tuesday, Dec. 23 (2)
 - o Wednesday, Dec. 24 Thursday, Dec. 25: University Holidays, No class
 - o Wednesday, Dec. 24 through Sunday, Jan. 4: Winter Recess Starts; University is closed
- Friday, Dec. 26 (1)
- Monday, Dec. 29 Wednesday, Dec. 31 (3)
 - o Thursday, Jan. 1, 2026: University Holiday, No class
 - o Friday, Jan. 2: President's Designated Holiday, No class
 - Sunday, Jan. 4: End of Winter Recess
- Monday, Jan. 5 Friday, Jan. 9 (5)
- Tuesday, Jan. 13, 2026: Grades are due by 5:00 pm (Eastern Time)
 - Grades posted after being processed
- Monday, Jan. 12, 2026: Spring Semester Starts 2025-2026 Academic Calendar
 - 3 weeks of Winter Break this year

What Will Class be Like? - Planning for Success

- 3 credits in 3-weeks
 - o Normally students earn 3 credits in a span of 15-weeks
 - o This means Winter Courses require a larger time commitment each week. (Up to 30hrs.)
- Access Brightspace Early
 - o Pay Attention to the announcements made via Brightspace
 - Professors don't always email the class with important information, so be sure to check Brightspace regularly.
- Read the syllabus!
 - Write important dates on a planner/Calander
 - o Have all necessary materials before the first day of class (textbooks, notebooks, etc.)
- Coursework, Assignments, and Tests
 - Will be compact throughout the three weeks. Be mindful of holidays and due dates
- Reach out to your faculty member as soon as you have questions
- Make sure to have a reliable internet connection.
- Time management is crucial!
 - Set aside a designated time to work on your course every day. Plan around other important events work/family

Registration and Withdrawals

- Students must withdraw from their course if they do not intend to take it. There is no Administrative Drop for not confirming enrollment like Fall and Spring.
- o Sunday, Dec. 21: Last day to receive a 100% refund for withdrawing from a course
- Monday, Dec. 22: Session Starts; Last day to withdraw without a "W"
- Tuesday, Dec. 23: NEW H-Ready Courses Last day to request Honors grade mode for PSY 120 and ENGL 286. <u>Submit request via Scheduling Assistant</u>
- Wednesday, Jan. 7: Last day to withdraw with a "W" complete the Withdraw form in myPurdue to drop course
- Students withdrawing from their winter course assignments after classes have begun should go to <u>myPurdue</u>, Registration tab, and look for Withdraw Information
 - Office of Dean of Students will process withdrawals as students would be withdrawing from a term
