




What is Financial Responsibility?

Financial Responsibility is a formal acknowledgement that students agree to fulfill their financial obligations to the university. Students can review and update their annual agreement by clicking their Student Account checklist via mypurdue.purdue.edu and click the link “*Affirmance of Financial Responsibility*”. Doing so will automatically release the hold on your account. Lack of compliance will result in your inability to register for classes, including the ability to drop or add courses.
