

The Learning Contract is an agreement with you and your researcher to be revisited every semester to insure optimal research outcomes.

1. When you login in to OURConnect, next to the Account Tab, select the drop down 'My Learning Contracts':




2. Choose the specific Learning Contract you are interested in completing or updating and select it:

3. You will now see four tabs: Project Detail, Application Detail, Agreement, and History:




4. Project Detail will autofill based on the project information submitted:



5. Application Detail will autofill based on application information submitted:



6. Agreement: This is a written agreement/guideline between you and your mentor to set clear expectations and outcomes and to discuss specific behaviors and habits for optimal success;



- Objectives What new ideas, concepts, devices, technologies, analyses, data sets, designs, performances, verse, arguments, etc. might arise from this work?
 What are the specific student outcomes from participating in this project?
- Approach Explain the approach and methodology that this project will use to answer the questions posed in the project background. Address the individual contribution you expect to make toward this research or creative projects, and how your qualifications equip you for this role.
- **Dissemination** Where and when will you disseminate results (Purdue semester conferences, regional meetings, etc.)? Consider limitations with sharing.
- Recording/Reporting How will you track your effort and research (notebook, journal, blog)?
- Training What onboarding steps (such as certifications) will the student need to complete and who provides these experiences; what additional training is needed/provided.
- Expectations What other expectations were communicated? Consider meeting participation, work hours/days, training, additional readings, authorship rights, etc.
- Compensation Identify at least one of the following compensation methods.
 Please include amount and time frame
 - Academic Credit (e.g., 3 credits of ABC10100) and/or
 - Wage (e.g., \$15 per hour, 10 hours per week for 15 weeks)
 - Stipend/Scholarship (e.g., \$2,000 for Fall 2023, 10 hours per week or "e.g" for the OUR Scholarship Program, you can enter \$500 per Fall/Spring 20XX)
- Click the 'Approve as Applicant' tab if completed and the Learning Contract will now be available for review with your mentor (If you are unable to complete it in at one time, you can hit the 'Submit' tab to save your progress)
