





- Consistent with Online Learning 2.0, rolling out a new process for program approvals


# Monthly Census

# Top Ten Programs





*Rationale: The program's census has steadily decreased over the past four years. No certificate or degree is required for entry-level medical office administrative positions. Students may enroll in the Bachelor of Science in Health Care Administration (BSHCA) degree program to meet the qualifications for entry-level healthcare management positions.*
