The Office of the Provost at Purdue University invites nominations and applications for Associate Provost for Undergraduate Programs. This new position reports directly to the Vice Provost for Academic Affairs and will provide overall leadership for many of our undergraduate academic success programs. We seek a visionary leader that will work across all academic units and with the Office of Student Services to implement many of the key recommendations outlined in the *New Synergies* strategic plan under the goal “launching tomorrow’s leaders”.

The Associate Provost for Undergraduate Programs will have administrative oversight for the Undergraduate Studies Program, the University Honors Program, transfer credit initiatives, and summer school. The Associate Provost will serve as Provost Office liaison to the strategic plan core curriculum initiative, and will work closely with the Provost and the Vice Provost on matters concerning academic policy development and resource allocation to support new undergraduate program initiatives.

Qualifications:

The successful candidate will be a nationally-recognized academic leader, with experience in higher education administration related to undergraduate academic programs. A demonstrated commitment to enhancing undergraduate programs and to the success of our students is essential. This position is open to tenured Purdue faculty at the rank of Full Professor.
