Vet Up! College is a six-week-long residential summer program at the Purdue University College of Veterinary Medicine for 26 educationally or economically disadvantaged **undergraduate students** that will prepare students to be competitive in the DVM applicant pool. *Vet Up! College replaces Purdue Veterinary Medicine's Access to Animal-Related Careers (A²RC) 2-week-long summer program which has been discontinued.*

- Work with Purdue Veterinary Medicine faculty, staff, and students to learn about careers in veterinary medicine shortage areas, explore important issues in the veterinary profession, and gain animal experience
- Experience the DVM curriculum with lectures, labs, and practice exams
- Develop effective strategies for learning, setting career goals, overcoming obstacles, and sustaining progress towards your goals
- Learn what it takes to prepare a competitive application for veterinary medical college
- Explore strategies to minimize educational debt
- Complete the Student Certificate for Diversity and Inclusion in Veterinary Medicine, participate in community service activities, and visit cultural centers
- Capitalize on the value of diverse teams through team projects and study sessions
