

## **Purdue University Post 9/11 GI Bill Yellow Ribbon Fact Sheet**

### **Criteria**

- Applicants must provide proof of application for the Post 9/11 GI Bill to be considered for the Yellow Ribbon remission of fees and must demonstrate proof of eligibility by providing their Certificate of Eligibility from the VA before any remission will be provided.
- Eligible for Ch 33 Post 9/11 GI Bill education benefits at the 100% level.
- Be admitted as a degree seeking student with tuition and fee charges above the VA's maximum in-state undergraduate rate as posted at [www.benefits.va.gov](http://www.benefits.va.gov).
- Maintain good academic standing.
- Students can be enrolled full or part time.
- Students must remain continuously enrolled and using GI Bill benefits each fall and spring semester to maintain their remission of fees. Exceptions may be made for those called to Active Military Duty.

Purdue University has agreed to remit fees up to \$3,500 for fall and \$3,500 for spring semesters to be matched by the VA for 50 qualified students each year. **Yellow Ribbon fee remissions will be awarded to qualified applicants on a first-come, first-served basis determined by the date this completed application is received by the School Certifying Officials located within the Veteran Success Center.**

Only individuals entitled to the maximum benefit rate (based on service requirements) may receive this funding.

Therefore, you may be eligible if:

- You served an aggregate period of active duty after September 10, 2001, of at least 36 months; or
- You were honorably discharged from active duty for a service connected disability and you served 30 continuous days after September 10, 2001; or
- You are a dependent eligible for Transfer of Entitlement under the Post-9/11 GI Bill based on a veteran's service under the eligibility criteria listed above.

Once selected for the Yellow Ribbon Program at Purdue, students will be awarded remission of fees each year they are in their current program of study or until degree is granted; **Purdue University reserves the right to discontinue the program or reduce the awards at the end of each academic year.**
