Develops new knowledge and skills. Demonstrates the ability to apply knowledge to varied situations & contexts.



#### Leadership

Develops leadership skills, develops group motivation skills. Communicates intensions & expectations effectively. Demonstrates understanding of group dynamics.



## Responsibility

Accepts responsibility, demonstrates professionalism, meets commitments. Reflects on consequences of one's own actions, recognizes strengths & weaknesses, develops critical learning.



#### Wellness

Physical & emotional health. Makes informed choices about alcohol & drug use, makes safe & healthy choices about sexual behavior. Develop financial literacy.



## What is the AfterClass Experience?

The AfterClass Experience is a variety of Student Affairs programs, activities, and experiences designed to educate the whole undergraduate student regardless of their major or career path. These experiences will encourage students to become engaged in campus life and assist students in feeling more connected to the University and their peers. # The Co-Curricular Transcript

All experiences tracked through BoilerLink will become part of an official Co-Curricular transcript. This transcript will be very beneficial to students as it can be used in interviews for internships, admission to graduate school, and interviews for full time employment. Employers are especially interested in what kinds of experiences students have had in developing a leadership, decision-making, acceptance of responsibility and appreciation of diverse ideas, backgrounds, and lifestyles. These can now be documented as part of an official transcript.
