Impact Awards Nomination

Award Criteria

- **Student Life Service Award**
Purdue Alumni who have demonstrated a commitment to their community through the development of/or significant contributions to private or public programs that improve or enhance the quality of life for individuals, families and communities. Letters of nomination should address how the nominee has made significant contributions to his/her community, and their contributions or involvement with a Student Life area or areas at Purdue University.
- **Student Life Award for Outstanding Leadership**
Purdue Alumni who have exceptional careers and shown long-term leadership within his/her chosen profession; noteworthy professional accomplishments that reflect favorably on his/her profession, Purdue University and society. Letters of nomination should address significant career accomplishments such as results and impact of programs launched through the nominee's efforts, how the nominee has displayed leadership within his/her chosen profession, and/or the noteworthy contributions that makes him/her worthy of this award, and their contributions or involvement with a Student Life area or areas at Purdue University.
- **Student Life Distinguished Mentor Award**
Awardees can include non-alumni. Distinguished Mentor Award honors and promotes the considerable efforts and accomplishments of individuals who consistently serve as effective mentors for students in areas within the Division of Student Life at Purdue University.
- **Student Life Young Alumni Award**
Purdue Alumni 35 or younger; outstanding career development either through traditional channels or innovative approaches. Letters of nomination should address how the nominee has shown support for his/her profession; involvement in professional organizations, college alumni association or community activities, and any continued involvement with Student Life since graduating.
