THE INTERNET OF THINGS (IOT)

The Internet of Things (also known as IoT) is the process of connecting digital devices to the internet. The devices send and receive data, making them "smart". Smart devices, like smartphones and Alexa, are great examples of IoT. They collect, receive, and transmit data via the web to perform tasks easily. IoT and datahandling extends to cars, cameras, sensors, power facilities etc. With more collected data, we can analyze and improve process control.

One practical example of the IoT is smart plants which use sensors to gather real time data about energy and power consumption.
