

I2R GUIDELINES

Guidelines Agreement

All participants must adhere to the following guidelines indicated below. Inability to follow these guidelines will result in expulsion from the program.

1. Innovation to Reality (I2R) is geared towards middle school students in grades 6th, 7th, and 8th
2. All participants must wear their identification badge at all times while on campus.
3. Participants must remain with I2R personnel at all times.
4. Participant's behavior must be respectful toward I2R personnel and fellow participants at all times. This includes refraining from the use of any personal electronic devices during I2R without permission from the staff.
5. Parents/legal guardians are financially responsible for damages to any University facility caused by their registered participant.
6. Transportation is the responsibility of the participant's parent or legal guardian.
7. For each session, participants must be in the designated room by the assigned starting time and picked up by the assigned ending time.
8. Pick-up by anyone other than the parent/legal guardian requires expressed consent of the parent/legal guardian. This consent must be submitted in writing with the signature of the parent/legal guardian.
